  - i. water plant no. 1, Phase 3.
- e. wastewater treatment plant discharge permit renewals;
- f. deeds, easements, plats, surveys, as-built certifications, appraisals, phase I environmental assessments, consents to encroachment, and utility commitment requests; and
- g. proposals for engineering services.
- 15. Harris County Fresh Water Supply District No. 51 water plant rehabilitation and upgrade project.
- 16. Operator's report, including:
  - a. operation, maintenance, and repair of District water, sanitary sewer, and storm drainage facilities;
  - b. customer billing and collection;
  - c. smart meter installation program;
  - d. amendment of Rate Order; and
  - e. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
