

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 285

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 285 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, December 18, 2017, at 6:30 p.m.**, at Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2600, in the Neches Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Minutes of prior meetings.
2. Hear statements from the public and receive written questions.

4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and amendment of budget, if necessary.

 - ii. New Forest Town Center water and sanitary sewer extensions;
 - d. approve pay estimates, time extensions, change orders, certificates of completion and final acceptance for projects in the service area, including:
 - i. wastewater treatment plant no. 2 expansion, including trifurcation;
 - ii. New Forest Town Center detention facilities; and
 - iii. wastewater treatment plant no. 1 fine screen replacement;
 - e. water plant storm water pump station and force main;
 - f. wastewater discharge permit renewals;

- g. deeds, easements, plats, surveys, as-built certifications, appraisals, and consents to encroachment;
 - h. utility commitment requests; and
 - i. proposals for engineering services.
13. Operator's report, including:
- a. update on operation, maintenance, and repair of District water, sanitary sewer, and storm water facilities;
 - b. update on customer billing and collection;
 - c. District sanitary sewer manhole survey report;
 - d. landscaping at wastewater treatment plant no. 1;
 - e. authorize execution of Discharge Monitoring Report Address and Signatory Authority Form; and
 - f. update on Texas Commission on Environmental Quality enforcement action.
